

## September to November 2015 rainfall forecast




## Regional drought potential advisory

Based on rainfall anomaly classification over the past six months and forecast rainfall anomaly classification over the next 3 months

**Fiji, Tonga:** Below to well below normal rainfall observed for 4 of the past 5 months. Below normal rainfall is forecast for both island groups from September to November.

**Papua New Guinea, Vanuatu:** Below to well below normal rainfall experienced in July and August with below normal rainfall forecast over the next 3 months.

**Niue, New Caledonia:** Below to well below normal rainfall observed for 3 of the past 6 months. Normal or below normal rainfall is forecast for New Caledonia and below normal rainfall is expected in Niue from September to November.
