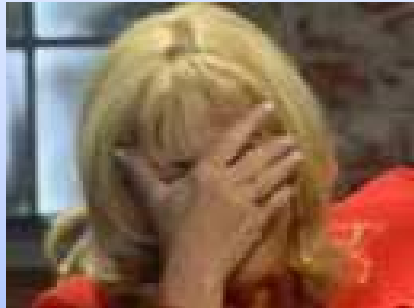
Behind the Scene

Dragons Den Rules

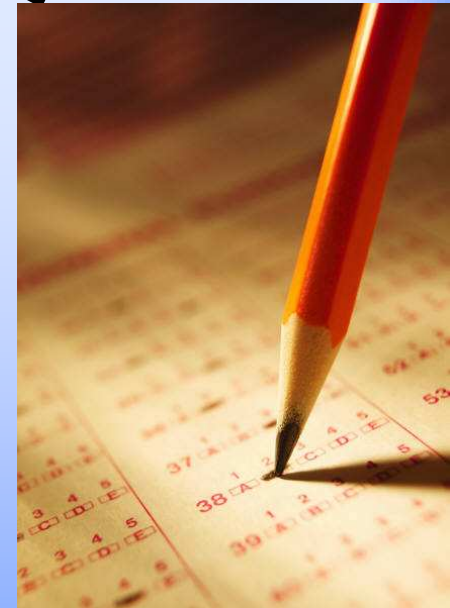
- 7 Dragons – who shall be obeyed and.... RESPECTED

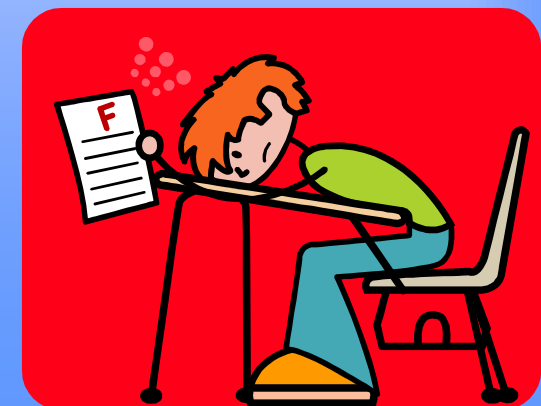
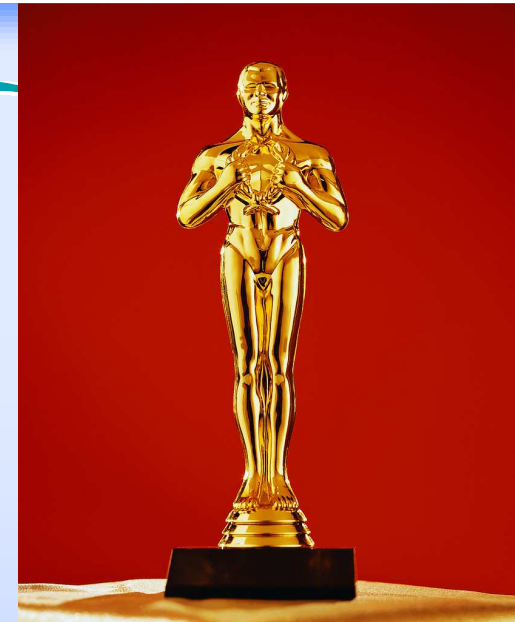
